March 8, 2025 - Many have died so others breathe easily. From behind bars in jails, where light can be found in the mind and heart of prisoners, I sent greetings to militant and progressive women everywhere on the earth. This year we welcome March 8th in demanding days of women activities. Anywhere I look, the odor of women's achievements diffuses blissfully and I am happy that the chain of militancy among women in the 21 century gets reinforced, every day. It has been often said that the 21st century is the century of women's freedom and it is only with that society progresses towards liberation.

The third World war is proceeding and this matter affects affairs and layouts in the Middle East. This war happens by policies of the state officials who are anti-women and homophobic and are not concerned with the will of society and in particular, women's demands. On the contrary it results in endangering their existence. In 2024, nationalities and sovereigns often opposed each other. Although homophobia expanded, resistance also intensified! While nationstates-maintained wars, the society fought for peace and democracy.

Nationalism and regionalism became the basic policy of states, instead society asserted equality and national -religious diversity. Special on Nurses and Medical Staff Hard life for nurses

Some of them come to Tehran to work and sleep in their cars at night. The Hem Mihan newspaper wrote: One shift in the hospital, the next shift driving passengers. The last shift? Sleeping in a car, renting a bed in a dormitory or boarding house, or living in a shared house. 14 to 15 million Tomans per month is not enough to live on. Overtime is 25,000 Tomans per hour. If they work eight hours of overtime, they do not get more than 200,000 Tomans. They also have to pay the same for transportation. In the past year, 400 nurses from Gilan province have migrated to Tehran. In Kermanshah, nurses work together, start a home nursing service company, rent a house together in Tehran, and leave.



March 12, 2025 Disabled people protest in front of the Presidential Institution

A group of disabled people held a protest rally in front of the Presidential Institution after months of correspondence and demands were not resolved, and in protest of the non-payment of arrears, the drafting of a subsistence allowance regulation that contradicts Article 27 of the Disabled People's Law, and the placement of all support services on hold.



March 12, 2025

Nurses in Arak hospitals have again gone on strike to protest the non-payment of their salaries and bonuses

Near Nowruz, employees protested the authorities' lack of attention to their livelihood and legal problems and announced that they could no longer live on these salaries. Some bosses have also told nurses that if they are unhappy with the conditions, they can resign and they will hire nurses from other cities. **Dehloran** emergency personnel gather to protest against low salaries, low housing and food allowances, non-payment of benefits, and improper implementation of government directives, such as the directive to increase overtime for medical staff at universities of medical sciences.

The protesting nurses say that their demands have not been paid for months and that the new management has resorted to projection instead of solving the problems.

A nationwide strike and protest rally by clinical radiation workers in Fars Province

Following the discrimination that occurred in the health sector among medical staff and the lack of attention of relevant authorities to the demands of radiation workers and the exclusion of this hardworking group from the cycle of supportive decisions of the Ministry of Health and Medical Education, on Saturday, March 18, clinical radiation workers held a protest rally at the door of the central building of Fars University of Medical Sciences.

Owners of care and rehabilitation centers staged a protest rally in front of the Planning and Budget Organization for the umpteenth time in protest of non-payment of arrears for the first five months of the year.



All nurses working in ICU 3 of Al-Zahra Hospital in **Isfahan** have officially gone on strike to protest the non-payment of legal fees and the hospital authorities' continued disregard for the staff's demands.



A protest rally of medical staff in **Tabriz** in front of the city's health center in the Nazrā area. The nurses, paramedics, and other medical personnel gathered, holding placards, demanding immediate payment of arrears and addressing their livelihood and welfare problems. Staff of Tabriz 115 gathered in front of the governor's office in protest against the authorities' failure to fulfill their promises Apparently, after widespread protests by the emergency personnel of East Azerbaijan University of Medical Sciences 115, the head of the university, Dr. Jodani dismissed the head of the university's emergency center yesterday.
