



Call for a rally

The French trade union organizations CFDT, CGT, UNSA, Solidaires and FSU, as well as:

- trade union organizations from several countries,
- the “Organizing Committee” established by Iranian diaspora organizations,

are calling for a rally in Geneva on June 5 in front of the United Nations headquarters, where the annual conference of the International Labour Organization (ILO) is taking place.

We aim, through this rally:

- to denounce the presence of representatives of the Islamic Republic of Iran at this conference;
- to reaffirm our solidarity with workers in Iran and with all those who are exploited and oppressed, who are struggling against the regime’s oppression while suffering the violence of war.

This rally calls for:

An immediate end to the war in this region;

The unconditional release of all political prisoners and prisoners of conscience;

The immediate end to arrests, torture, and executions;

The immediate restoration of Internet access;

The right to form organizations independent of state power;

The right to strike and demonstrate, job security, and the enforcement of health and safety standards in the workplace;

Living conditions that allow for a dignified life;

Wages in line with the cost of living.
